May 13th Breakfast Run Joe's Farm Grill

The May Breakfast Putt is on Saturday, May 13th, at Joe's Farm Grill, 3000 E. Ray Road Gilbert, AZ 85296 (just west of Higley Road),

We will meet at McDonald's on Indian Bend and 101 (Pavilions). Leave at 8:30 am.

We will be Heading south on the 101 to the 60 and take the East exit toward Globe. Exit at Higley Road and turn right (south) on Higley. Travel 4.5 miles and turn right on Ray Road. About 1/8th mile turn into the parking lot, most of the lot is gravel/dirt.

Bring your walking shoes; you can tour the garden areas if you wish.

There are also a few shops on site that you may want to browse.

If the weather is nice you may want to stop by the Riparian Preserve at Water Ranch; It's a short drive and on the way home. Location of the Preserve: 2757 E Guadalupe Rd, Gilbert, AZ 85234 riparianinstitute.org. Leave Joe's Farm

grill by turning right (west) onto Ray Road.

In less than a mile turn right (north) onto Greenfield Rd. Go three miles to Guadalupe Road and turn right (east). You can park in the library parking lot or go east a little further to the Preserve parking lot.

Again, bring your walking shoes, there are paths along the seven ponds, and enjoy the birds and vegetation.

There are also nice quiet seating areas. If you have an Arizona urban fishing license bring your pole and try your luck.

You can also feed the ducks cracked corn, wheat, barley or similar grains, oats, birdseed, grapes (cut in half), defrosted frozen peas or corn, earthworms, mealworms or duck pellets; Do not feed the ducks bread, chips, crackers, biscuits, popcorn or any sugary foods-sweets, chocolate.
