It was so much fun to drive past the crowd and receive the plaque that was prepared for us. Later we looked at it and noticed that they had the owners as Ron and Jon Olmstead! LOL That was our 1st encounter with OTHG! That however did not stop us from approaching Ken and Dee to sponsor us to become OTHG members.

I have enjoyed being a part of a great group of people who have become good friends.

I currently have a '30 modified roadster that I drag race and a '35 Ford 3 window coupe. Like most old hot rodders the older I get the faster I was.
